February 2015



These events start with a 2 day first aid course for club members on Saturday 14.02.15 to Sunday 15.02.15. This will be followed by a skills session catering for the three club paddling disciplines, open canoe, sea kayak and river kayak which will be held on Sunday 1 March 2015 at Loch Lomond.

We are also planning to promote the star test scheme giving club members the opportunity to be streamed into sessions with other persons of similar ability to work towards formal assessments. The club will also provide a Foundation Safety and Rescue Course in either April or May.


