# **Star Test Training/Assessments**




# 2 Star Assessment Course - Tuesday 7th July 9.30am at outdoor store


#### **Child Protection Course**

#### **New Clydebank Leisure Centre**

You may have heard that the pool we use for our pool sessions between September and April is going to be demolished and a new pool built as part of the Clydebank Leisure Centre. We have been in discussion with the developers of the new building and we hope to have some storage for boats inside the new building which is due to open in January 2017.

We will not be able to store a huge number of boats in the new building and this will reduce the number of boats that we can put into the pool during the pool session. This will mean that pool sessions in the new pool will have to be more organised but on the plus side we will not have to cart boats completely round the building before and after each club pool night. Nothing is set in stone at



the moment however discussions have been encouraging and we hope to move forwards with this project.

# **Loch Lomond Watersports Hub**



Drumchapel and Clydebank Kayak Club is one of the primary organisations involved in the creation of this Watersports hub. Supported by West Dunbartonshire Council some of the other organisations involved are Loch Lomond Rowing Club, Loch Lomond Waterski Club and Lomond Masters Triathlon Club. Together these organisations make up the Loch Lomond Watersports Association (LLWA).

Our Club is involved in this joint project whose purpose is to build a shore based facility near to where we normally meet for our Tuesday night sessions at the South end of Loch Lomond which will include equipment storage, changing rooms, meeting rooms and a café. In effect this proposed building, artist impression above, should provide us with a permanent base for the club just next to the mouth of the River Leven where it flows out of Loch Lomond.

#### Watersports Hub Project - Update and Volunteers Needed!

You may have heard someone talking about the loch Lomond Watersports Hub so here is a wee update on what's been happening on that front.



Exciting things are about to happen which if successful, could mean a brand new home at Loch Lomond with a building which would be shared by us, Loch Lomond Waterski Club, Open Water Swimming and Triathlon Club and Loch Lomond Rowing Club. We are in the process of finalising grant applications for 2 large grants (submission by end of June) which would allow the project to come to fruition. We also have to launch the proposals at Focus Group Sessions planned for Tuesday 23rd June and Thursday 25th June at the National Park Headquarters, followed by a Public Launch Event on Saturday 27th June at Loch Lomond Shores.

The project is gaining momentum but **HELP IS REQUIRED** for the next step. Urgently we need someone who would be willing to coordinate SOCIAL MEDIA. The volunteer would just need to post updates and information on Facebook and Twitter. Accounts for both Facebook and Twitter have already been established, therefore it would just mean posting updates from time to time.



We will have food and other goodies for helpers as the days are part funded by a grant we received.






# **July Activities!**
